

Lesson plan for teachers of ESOL (English for Speakers of Other Languages) devised to raise awareness of the symptoms of TB and the importance of being registered with a GP.

Introduction

This set of ESOL teaching materials has been designed for adult learners from Entry 1 to Level 2. The materials were designed and written by an experienced ESOL teacher in partnership with the local NHS Community TB Team, a Public Health Specialist and Greenwich Community College.

The lesson uses a number of different teaching techniques including practical work, discussion, question and answer, and short written tests, all focused on the story of a young Nepalese man, Raju, who develops TB. The story follows him as he is diagnosed, treated and eventually cured.

In the final stage of the lesson, students work in groups to design and produce a poster to raise awareness of TB.

The content of these teaching materials will prove particularly useful in student groups who were born in countries that have a high incidence of TB and who would benefit from increased awareness of the symptoms.



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
